

Reverse Lookup Directory: Trace Phone Number Owner

Use reverse lookup directories to find the owner info of U.S. number.

Chicago, IL (<u>BizHWY</u>) November 11, 2010 - Unidentified phone calls can be traced with a <u>reverse lookup</u> directory that uses multiple private and public data sources from court records to restricted cell phone provider databases. In order to do a reverse number search, you will need to choose the directory that has both land line and mobile records.

You can visit the service below to check the number's registered location and phone owner name. In some cases you will be able to look up further details by running a background check. Background checks are searches by name that can provide very detailed information about the person. This info usually includes his or her address, criminal and divorce records (if any) and more.

Free reverse lookups are possible for land line and published numbers. Most cell phone numbers are unlisted which means that a detailed directory quiery will not be free. Most cell phone records are compiled manually and are therefore available only through premium listings.
